

WHITES

Sauvignon Blanc - Duckhorn (USA)

A smooth-textured entry gives way to tingling acidity that shows off the citrus elements while adding length to flavors of cantaloupe, Asian pear and Fuji apple. The finish is persistent and refreshing with long mineral notes.

Chardonnay - Esser Vineyard (USA)

This beautifully expressive Chardonnay leads with tropical fruit aromas and accents of citrus and lemon blossoms. It feels rich and round on the palette and is framed by ample acidity. Notes of lemon curd, pineapple and vanilla are followed by a pleasantly crisp finish

Sauvignon Blanc - Henry Marionnet (France)

Flavors of lime, apple and a hint of vine leaf. Very fresh and not intense. Simple and easy to drink

Semillon - Chateau Minuty (France)

The nose is full and complex with floral and fruity with delicate vanilla notes. The palate is generous with notes of peach and apricot and a long slightly toasted and buttery finish. An easy-drinking wine but with character, it can be enjoyed with or without food.

Cote de Provence - Premiere de Figuiere (France)

A rose in all its qualities. A bouquet that breathes the Provence with a hint of citrus fruit and spices.

Starting with a clean nose of citrus fruit, it is fresh, elegant, crisp with a beautiful strawberry and cherry flavors.

Moet Chandon – Imperial (France)

The palate is seductive, richly flavorful and smooth, followed by a delicately fresh crispiness to reveal the magical balance of Champagne.

Prosecco – Danzante (Italy)

Produced from prosecco grapes grown in the hills of Treviso. This is Italy's favorite sparkling wine.

RED

Pinot Noir- Robert Mondavi Private Selection (USA)

Robert Mondavi was a pioneer in producing wines that rival the world's finest. This pinot noir unfolds in elegant, silky layers of wild cherries, berries and aromatic spices. Warm oak nuances linger on the finish.

Merlot – St. Francis (USA)

Smooth and elegant with classic flavors and aromas of cherry, red licorice, currant and dried cranberry. Its silky structure is balanced by soft tannins and a bold, lengthy finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon – Robert Mondavi Private Selection

(USA)

Sweet black cherry and dark berry fruit character that distinguishes California's finest. Its ripe fruit is supported by velvety tannins and well-integrated oak. This is a wine of excellent depth, richness and length on the palette.

Merlot – Little Black Dress (USA)

Rich with flattering aromas of ripe black cherry, cranberry and warm herb, complemented by hints of vanilla and toasted oak. This medium-bodied merlot can seduce even the most experienced of palates with a nice lingering finish.

Cotes du Rhone – Domaine de Cristia (France)

Intense garnet with violet highlights. Clean intense nose. A solid presence on the palette of cherry stones with hints of licorice and pepper.

Bordeau Claret – La Reserva (France)

Rich fruit and berries and and typical Right Bank Saint-Emilion nose. Pure black cherry and berry aromas lead to a full body with silky tannins and a concentrated fruity finish.

Remole Toscana – Frescobaldi (Italy)

*A blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon.
Faceted aromas of red and dark fruit lifted by
spicier impressions of black pepper and licorice.*

*Fruit driven with a dominance of classic cherry
and red berry characters supported with hints of
